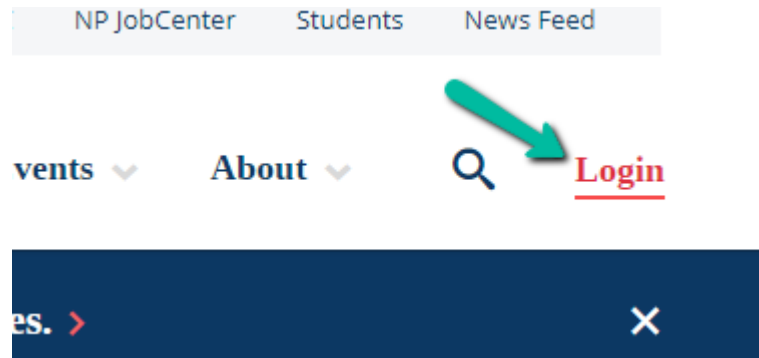


Make Sure You Have AANP Account

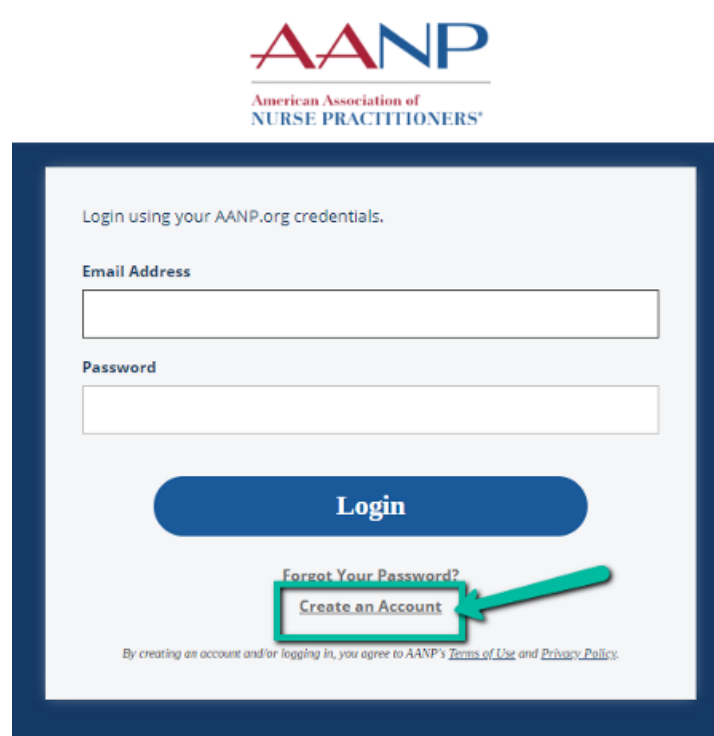
If you have an AANP account, you can skip this step!

If you don't have an AANP account, please go to the AANP Website at <https://aanp.org> and click on the red **Login** hyperlink in the upper right corner of the browser.

On the next screen, look below the blue "Login" button and click the link that says **Create an Account**.

Go through the account creation process and provide the required information (denoted by a * beside the field name). You will be asked to enter some personal information, create a password and provide contact information. Click the blue “Submit” button at the bottom of the screen when done.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Creating an AANP account will create a non-member (FREE) account by default. You will not be asked to sign up for a membership or enter any payment information during this step. You do not need to be an AANP member to complete this activity or receive CE credit.

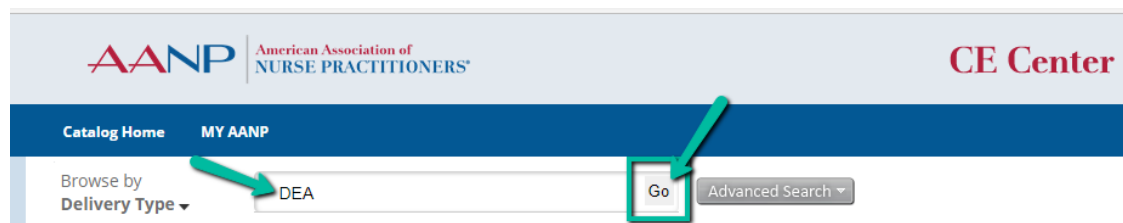

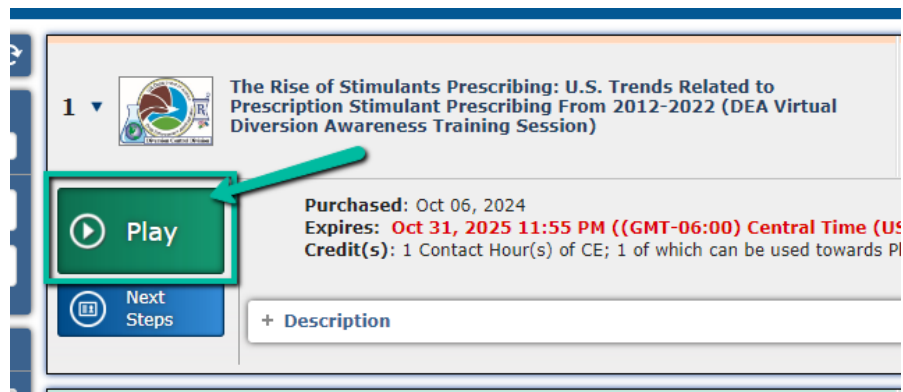

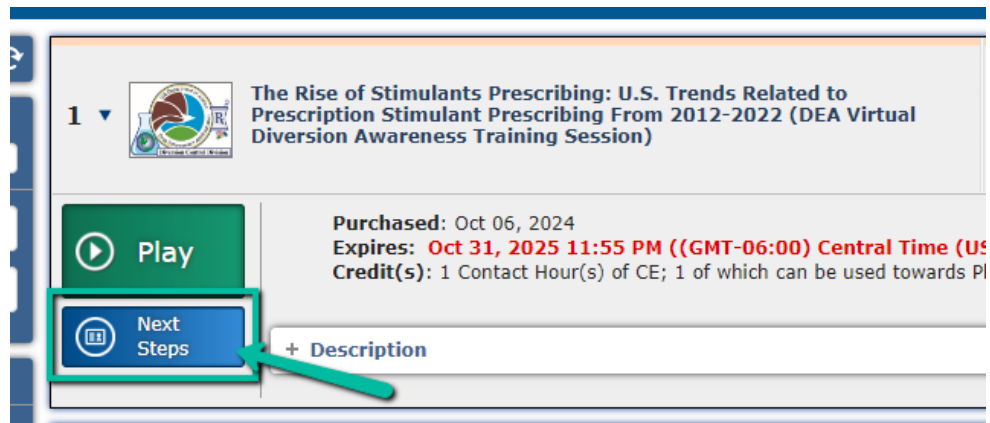
