

ARCOS Reporting

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Reporting Requirements

- 21 United States Code, § 827 requires manufacturers and distributors to maintain complete and accurate records and to make such reports as required on those records.
- 21 Code of Federal Regulations § 1304.33 requires ARCOS reporters to report:
 - Monthly or Quarterly
 - Year-End Inventory

Error Correction

- DEA cannot change any data. The ARCOS reporter is the only entity having the SOURCE document's to effect corrections.
- Corrections to Error can be submitted prior to the next monthly or quarterly report.

ARCOS Data

- Is used not only by the DEA but other government agencies.
- Polices, assets, and manpower are allocated in part from ARCOS analysis.
- Investigations against registrants are initiated based in part on ARCOS reporting.
