




Theft

* The taking of property without consent*

Quality Alarm system: Motion, noise and break sensitive. On doors and windows.

Alarm Company : Call to Police **FIRST!!**

Secured Building: Gates, bars, concrete barriers.

Lighting: Exterior and Interior.

What should I do during a robbery?

Comply without being helpful.

If *absolutely* necessary defend yourself or others.

Become the best witness.

Take note of identifiers: Tattoos, facial hair, clothing, footwear, gloves or not, logos.

Listen: What do they sound like, what did they say, names.

Watch: Who's the boss, what direction did they go, what did they touch.

You got robbed, now what?

Call the police first, then your boss.


Aid anyone injured.

Start to make a list of items taken.

Recover the security video for police.
